

Students listed out each and every task their mothers performed at home and then read the long list of chores mentioned in the textbook so that they could realise how much work the women in their homes do on a daily basis. The poem says that women do all the work at home so that their children are comfortable. It is an opportunity for the students to think about all the sacrifices a mother makes which have gone unnoticed and are taken for granted.
