The Department of Humanities and Sciences organized the industrial visit on 28th February, 2024 on the occasion of “National science Day”.



AS a part of science day celebration valedictory is conducted in the ground floor conference hall. The students shared their experiences about the industrial visit.



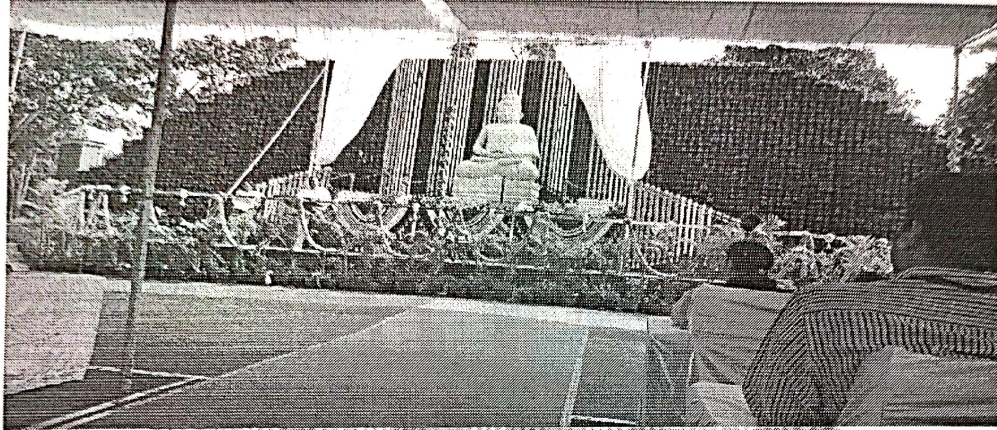
Republic Day celebrations

2. Solar Energy : Energy of Future 3. Green Technology

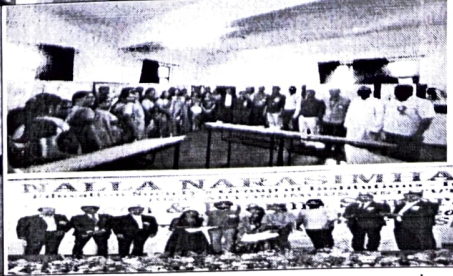
We made the participants think and grow concerned towards protecting the Environment while engineering program, students participated enthusiastically.
