OUTCOME:

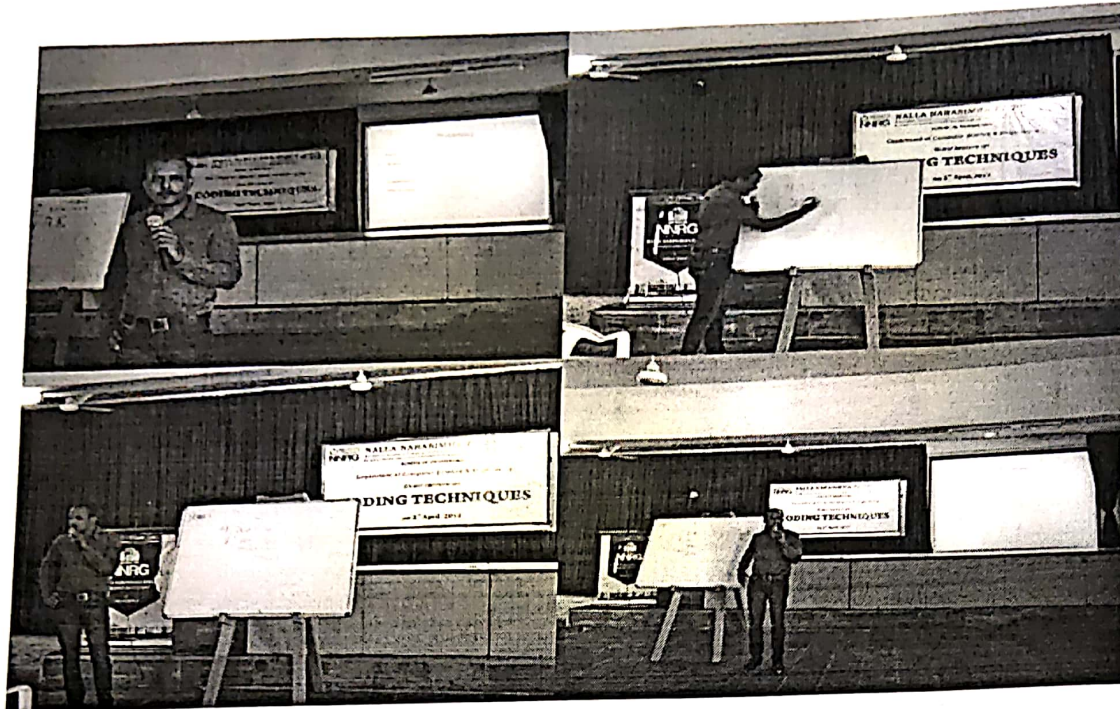
Students can carry out their mini and major projects and also got the skills to select the seminar topics.
