## REPORT ON "INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO GSITI, HYDERABAD"

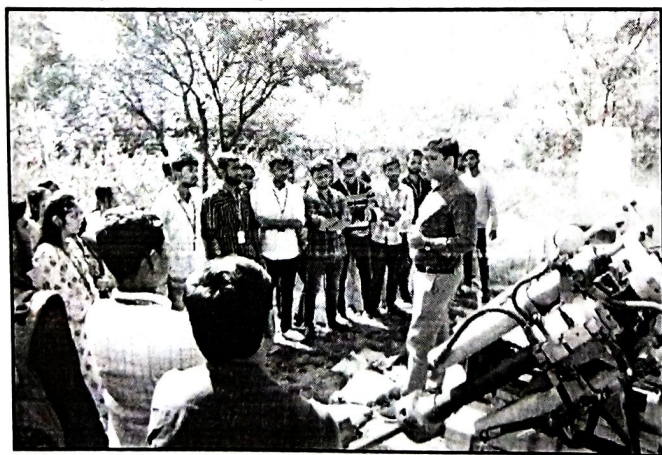
