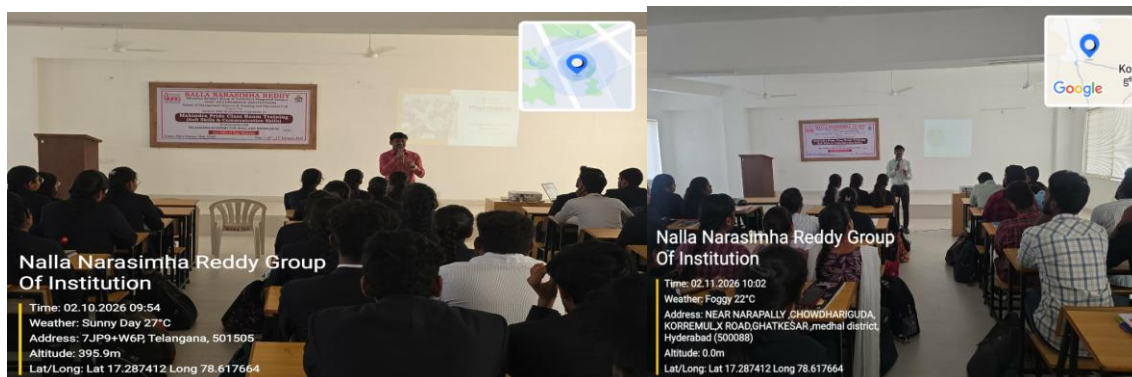
2. DEPARTMENT EVENTS

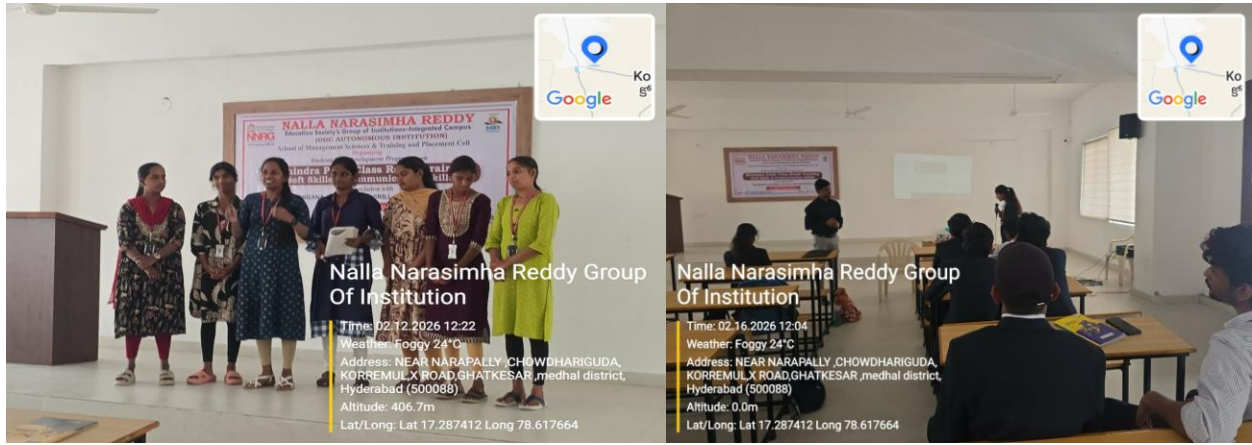
2.1 Skill Development Programme:
