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### ***Report on*** **WORKSHOP ON** **PHARMACOVIGILANCE AND CLINICAL DATA MANAGEMENT**

Career Opportunities in Medical Coding, Pharmacovigilance, Clinical Research, and Clinical Data Management

The School of Pharmacy, Nalla Narasimha Reddy Education Society's Group of Institutions (NNRG), successfully organized a Career Guidance Session on 2nd February 2024 in the Seminar Hall. The event aimed to enlighten final-year B.Pharmacy students about various emerging career domains beyond conventional pharmaceutical roles, with a particular focus on Medical Coding, Pharmacovigilance, Clinical Research, and Clinical Data Management.

The resource person for the session was Mr. Javed Hussain, Regional Manager at IKYA Global Education, a reputed organization known for its industry-oriented training and placement services in healthcare and life sciences sectors. Mr. Hussain delivered a highly informative and engaging session that provided students with a comprehensive understanding of the job roles, required skill sets, growth prospects, and training pathways in the discussed domains.

He elaborated on:

A total of 87 final-year B. Pharmacy students actively participated in the session, alongside faculty and staff members. The audience displayed keen interest, with many raising thoughtful questions during the interactive segment.
