WORLD TUBERCULOSIS DAY- 2026

On March 24, 2026, the **Pharmacology Club** School of Pharmacy-NNRG organized a comprehensive seminar to commemorate **World Tuberculosis Day**. The event aimed to spread awareness about the global TB epidemic and provide a comprehensive clinical and social perspective on the disease.

The seminar followed the 2026 global theme: "**Yes! We Can End TB: Led by Countries, Powered by People.**"

The event was structured to provide a 360-degree view of the disease, featuring four student speakers of III year who covered the clinical, biological, and socio-political aspects of TB.

- ❖ The **first student (B.Sravani-237Z1R0009)** provided a foundational overview of the disease like definition, Transmission, classification and History
- ❖ The **second student (A.Mahesh-237Z1R0002)** delved into the biological mechanisms of the infection, which is crucial for a pharmacology.
- ❖ The **third student (CH.Sowjanya-237Z1R0018)** focused on the administrative and strategic fight against TB in India, specifically the **National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP)**.
- ❖ The **final speaker (B.Revanth-237Z1R0011)** presented the latest data, reflecting India's progress toward its ambitious goal of eliminating TB

The Program was attended by 45 III-yr B.Pharmacy students and they were actively participated, along with faculty members of the School of Pharmacy.

The lecture concluded with an interactive Q&A session where students clarified doubts regarding modern oncological treatments and palliative care. The event was highly successful in enhancing the technical knowledge of the students and instilling a sense of professional responsibility toward public health.

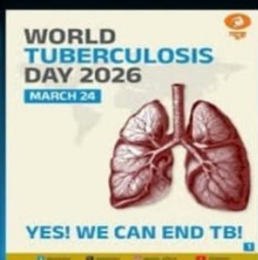
