REPORT ON

FIELD VISIT

As part of its commitment to experiential learning and industry-academia interface, the School of Pharmacy at Nalla Narasimha Reddy Education Society's Integrated Campus organized a two-day industrial visit to Stride Organics Private Limited, a reputed pharmaceutical manufacturing facility in Telangana, on December 13th and 14th, 2024.

The primary objective of the visit was to offer students practical exposure to real-time pharmaceutical manufacturing and industrial processes, thereby enhancing their understanding of concepts taught in the classroom. A total of 90 students, guided by four faculty members, participated in the visit, which served as an enriching experience in line with the academic curriculum.

During the visit, students were given a detailed orientation on the operations of Stride Organics, including its production units, quality control laboratories, packaging sections, and regulatory compliance frameworks. The technical team at Stride Organics demonstrated several key aspects of pharmaceutical manufacturing such as:

- Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP)
- Equipment handling and maintenance
- Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
- Batch manufacturing processes
- Quality assurance and quality control techniques
- Documentation and regulatory standards followed in the industry

Students observed the functioning of various departments, including formulation development, analytical research, and quality control, allowing them to gain firsthand insight into how theoretical knowledge is applied in an industrial setting.

The interaction also emphasized the importance of compliance with safety protocols, regulatory standards such as WHO-GMP and Schedule M, and environmental considerations in pharmaceutical manufacturing.


Faculty members facilitated discussion sessions, encouraging students to ask questions and engage with the professionals at the facility. The visit concluded with a feedback session where

students shared their observations and learnings, acknowledging the value of such experiences in preparing for careers in the pharmaceutical industry.

Conclusion:

The industrial visit to Stride Organics Private Limited was highly beneficial in bridging the gap between academic instruction and practical implementation. It enabled students to better understand the dynamics of the pharmaceutical manufacturing sector and inspired them to pursue professional excellence in their future endeavors.
