GUEST LECTURE ON

“CAREER GUIDANCE FOR HIGHER EDUCATION IN INDIA

(THROUGH GPAT AND NIPER)”

School of Pharmacy has conducted a Guest Lecture by Dr. Dinesh Neeradi, Director, Masters Academy, Hyderabad for the students of B.Pharmacy III and IV year on 30/09/2021, at Nalla Narasimha Reddy Education Society's Group of Institutions, Hyderabad.

The students participated in the webinar on 15/09/2021 which was organized by Masters Academy, Hyderabad; they were influenced by the speech of Dr. Dinesh Neeradi and requested the Dean, School of Pharmacy to arrange a Guest Lecture at the institute exclusively for the students of NNRG, School of Pharmacy.

Summary:

- Dr. Dinesh explained students not to stop their education at B.Pharmacy level. Encouraged them to pursue M.Pharmacy by saying that M.Pharm graduates have a wide range of work opportunities and career paths to choose from.
- He mentioned that Admission in to M.Pharmacy course in Telangana state is based on entrance exams like NIPER, GPAT and PGECET. However, there are some seats may be allotted based on the marks secured by a candidate in his/her graduation under management quota.
- Dr. Dinesh explained about GPAT exam as one of the main competitive examination which have multiple advantages, where he mentioned that;
 - ✓ Student will be eligible to apply to the premier institutes of India like ICT, BITS Pilani, NIPER, IIT BHU, Other Universities and Affiliated colleges. etc.
 - ✓ The exam is conducted for admissions to 24000 seats of M.Pharm programs offered by as many as 841 pharmacy institutes across the country.
 - ✓ Student will be eligible for MHRD (Ministry of Human Resource Development), Govt. of India scholarship for doing masters degree.
 - ✓ Student will be eligible for a monthly stipend of Rs 12,400.
 - ✓ If the student is research oriented, they can get an admission for Ph.D on the basis of the GPAT score provided you take admission just after PG. In that case, your GPAT score will be valid for 3 years.
 - ✓ JRF (Junior Research Fellowship) - student can join in a project of Pharmaceutical Sciences and related subjects.
 - ✓ Pharmacist - GPAT is not for entry into the job of “Pharmacist” but if you have qualified GPAT, your chances of qualifying the “Pharmacist” examination will be more.

- ✓ NIPERs are like IITs for pharmacy graduates to pursue their higher education in their field of interest.
- ✓ If a student wants to join any NIPER they must qualify in GPAT to get eligibility to appear for NIPER-JEE.
- ✓ A NIPERian will be given priority in industry at the time of recruitments and the salary will be more than others who have completed their Post graduation through GPAT or PGCET.

70 students from both III and IV year B.Pharmacy have attended the Guest Lecture and gained the knowledge on importance of GPAT and NIPER-JEE.
