### AWARENESS PROGRAM

The School of Pharmacy, NNRG, in collaboration with the NSS Unit, organized an awareness program on **World Hepatitis Day** on 28th July 2025. The theme for this year's event was **"Let's Break It Down"**, aiming to educate and sensitize students about the causes, prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of hepatitis.

The program was attended by **86 final-year B.Pharmacy students**, along with faculty members of the School of Pharmacy.

The resource person for the session was **Ms. T. Akhila**, Assistant Professor, Department of Pharmacology, School of Pharmacy, NNRG. She delivered an informative and engaging lecture on **"Awareness, Prevention, Diagnosis, and Treatment of Hepatitis"**. The talk covered key aspects such as:

- Types of hepatitis viruses (A, B, C, D, and E) and their modes of transmission.
- Preventive measures including vaccination, safe hygiene practices, and awareness of risk factors.
- Diagnostic methods for early detection.
- Available treatment options and the importance of timely medical intervention.

**Dr. Krishna Mohan Chinnala**, Dean, School of Pharmacy, addressed the gathering and emphasized the importance of awareness programs like these in shaping socially responsible pharmacists. He highlighted the pharmacist's role in educating the public about infectious diseases and the need for early diagnosis to prevent serious complications.

The interactive nature of the session encouraged students to ask questions and clarify their doubts, making it an impactful learning experience.

The World Hepatitis Day awareness program at NNRG served as a valuable platform for final-year pharmacy students to gain in-depth knowledge about hepatitis, empowering them to contribute effectively to public health awareness and disease prevention in their professional careers.
