Field Visit

On 12th August 2025, the final-year B.Pharmacy students of School of Pharmacy, Nalla Narasimha Reddy Education Society's Group of Institutions, undertook a field visit to the Telangana State Forest Academy, Dulapally, Telangana, as part of their academic enrichment activities. A total of 90 students participated in the visit, accompanied by Mr. S. Rajashekar and Mr. S. Satish, Assistant Professors, School of Pharmacy.

The primary objective of the visit was to provide students with practical exposure to medicinal plants and enhance their understanding of plant-based pharmacognosy concepts. During the visit, the students:

- Learned about the cultivation, propagation, and harvesting techniques of various medicinal and aromatic plants.
- Observed plant species of pharmacological significance and discussed their therapeutic uses and active constituents.
- Gained insights into conservation practices and the role of forest academies in biodiversity preservation.
- Explored the integration of traditional herbal knowledge with modern pharmaceutical research.

The faculty members guided students in identifying key species and linking their properties to pharmaceutical applications. The visit also provided an opportunity to interact with forestry experts, enriching the students' understanding of sustainable medicinal plant management.
