

### **Report: RAPID-22 Conference**

The National Conference on “Recent Advances in Pharmaceutical Innovations and Developments” (RAPID-22) took place at the NNRG School of Pharmacy on November 25 & 26, 2022. This two-day event provided a dynamic forum for researchers, professionals, and students to share the latest advancements and foster collaboration within the pharmaceutical sciences.

#### **Day 1: Inaugural and Research Showcases**

The first day of RAPID-22 began with registration and a welcoming session from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM, allowing attendees to check in and connect.

Following a final lunch break from 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM, the conference moved to its closing ceremony.

The Valedictory Function and Awards ceremony from 2:00 PM to 3:30 PM served as the capstone event. Conference highlights were recapped, and awards were presented to the best oral and poster presenters, celebrating the quality of research and presentation skills on display.
