Event: National Conference on "Recent Advances in Pharmaceutical Innovations and Developments" (RAPID-23)

Executive Summary

The "Recent Advances in Pharmaceutical Innovations and Developments" (RAPID-23) conference was a successful two-day event held on November 3rd and 4th, 2023.
