An interactive question-and-answer session was conducted, during which students clarified their doubts related to university selection, scholarship opportunities, career prospects, and immigration policies.

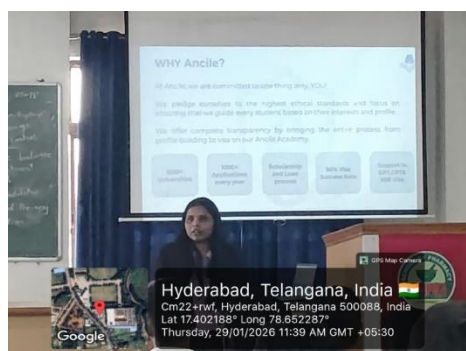
Learning Outcomes
