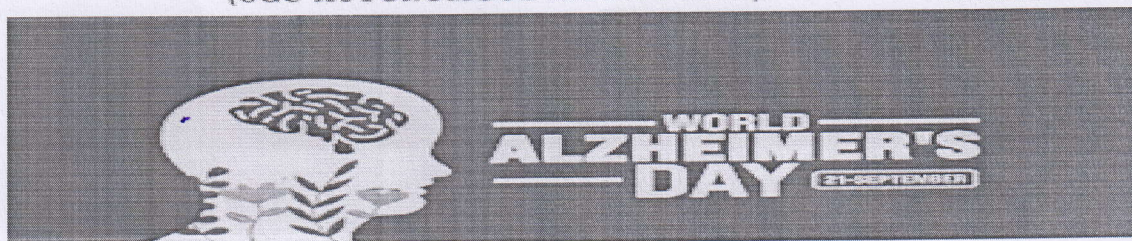
"World Alzheimer's Day"

September 21 is considered as World Alzheimer's Day. **Pharmacology club** of Nalla Narasimha Reddy (NNR) School of Pharmacy hosted an event in its conference hall to commemorate **World Alzheimer's Day**. As this year it fell on Sunday it is conducted on 22nd September 2025. The event, held for B.Pharm IV year students, where 62 students actively attended the session that featured **A. Suvarna**, Assistant Professor in the Department of Pharmacology at NNRSOP, as the resource person. The event's theme was **"Ask about Dementia. Ask about Alzheimer's."** The objective of the event is to educate future pharmacy professionals on a critical public health issues like neurodegenerative disorders specially Alzheimer's disease.

- The event was well-attended, with students actively participating in the session. The event successfully achieved its objective of educating future pharmacy professionals on a critical public health issue



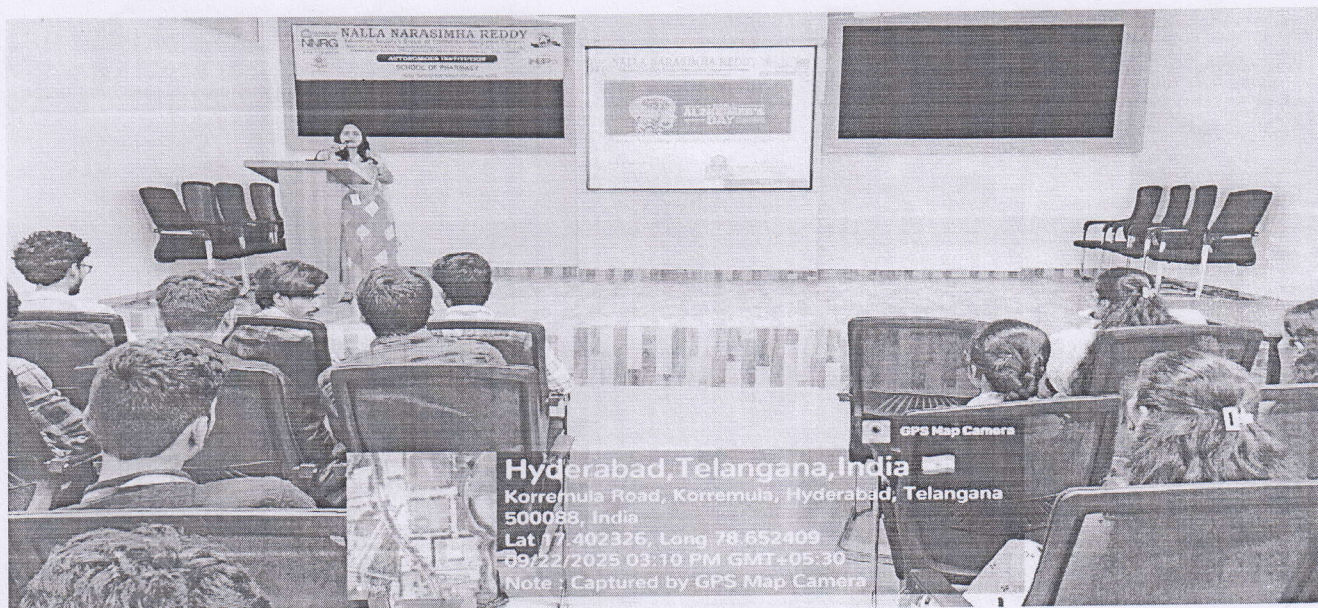

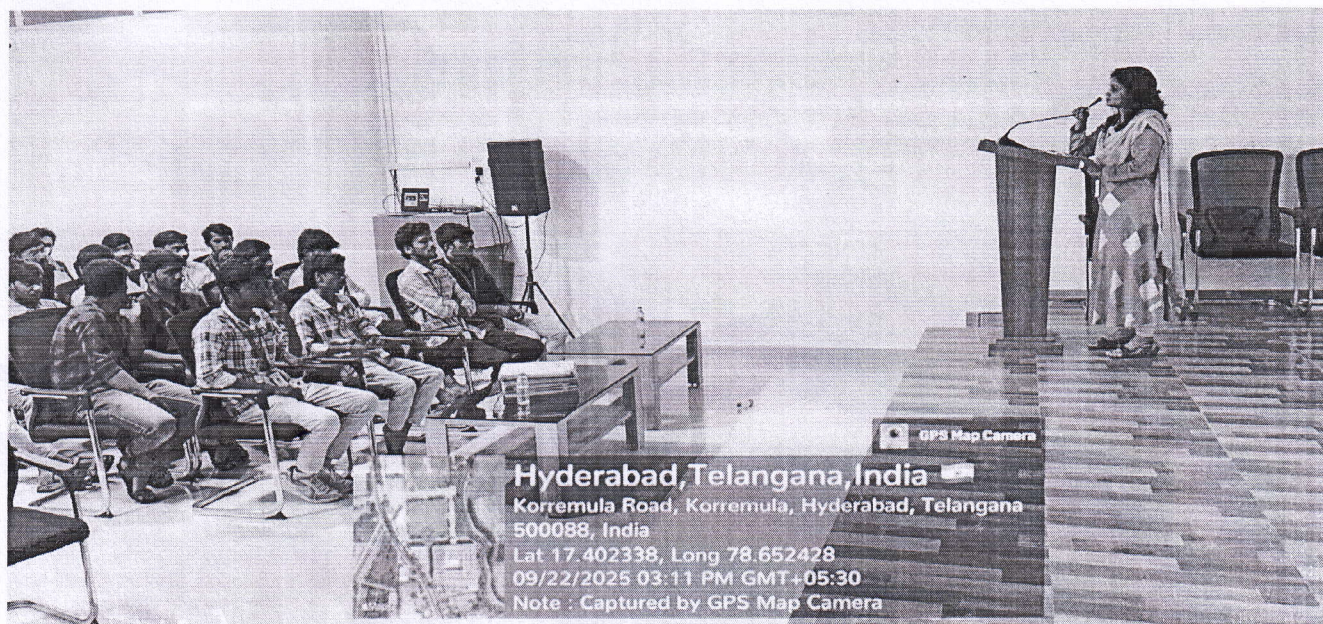

Event Overview
