PHARMACOVIGILANCE WEEK 2025

Pharmacology Club of Nalla Narasimha Reddy(NNR) school of Pharmacy celebrated the 5th National Pharmacovigilance Week from September 22nd to 27th 2025, with the theme “Your Safety, Just a click away: Report to PvPI”. The event aimed to raise awareness about the importance of Pharmacovigilance in ensuring patient safety and promoting public health. The event was mainly conducted for III yr students and 70 members were registered for this program.

Each day of the Pharmacovigilance week was focused on a different aspect of Pharmacovigilance by different subject experts.

Day:1

Session Title: “ An Introduction to Pharmacovigilance and PvPI”

Faculty: Dr.Krishna Mohan Chinnala

Key Takeaways:In this session the speaker introduced the concept of Pharmacovigilance, its importance and the role of PvPI in ensuring drug safety. Students learned about the various initiatives taken by PvPI to promote Pharmacovigilance.

Day: 2

Session Title: “ Your Safety, our Priority: The Journey of Pharmacovigilance in India and the World”

Key Takeaways: In this session the students learned the things like evolution of Pharmacovigilance significantly over the years in India and the regulatory bodies(WHO,ICH) who are providing guidelines for Pharmacovigilance, enabling proactive and adaptive approaches to drug safety monitoring.

Day: 3

Session Title: “ Drug Safety evaluation in special population”

Faculty: Sunanda Tummalapalli

Key Takeaways:The session is discussed the drug safety evaluation in special populations such as pregnant women, children, elderly may require special consideration when giving a drug and they are more susceptible to adverse drug reactions, emphasizing the need for careful monitoring and dose adjustments.

Day: 4

Session Title: “Drug and Disease classification”

Key Takeaways: This session makes the students to understand that the drugs are classified based on their pharmacological effects, therapeutic uses, and chemical structure while disease are classified using standardized systems like International Classification of Diseases(ICD).

Day: 5

Session Title: “Pharmacogenomics of Adverse Drugs Reactions”

Key Takeaways: In this session Speaker discussed about how the genetic variations affect an individual response to medication, increasing the risk of adverse drug reactions and how an healthcare providers can make treatment plans to minimize the risk of ADR's and optimize therapeutic efficacy.

Day: 6

Session Title: “Adverse drug Reactions and Drug interactions”

Faculty: Kavitha Vangala

Key Takeaways: This educational session was designed to provide a comprehensive understanding of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs), a critical aspect of patient safety and public health. The primary objective was to equip participants with the knowledge and practical skills necessary to effectively detect, assess, and report ADRs as part of their professional responsibilities.

Valedictory:

Valedictory session was conducted on last day of National Pharmacovigilance week by faculty Ms.A.Suvarna , Dept. of Pharmacology, SOP-NNRG. She discussed the summary of all the 6 days events and feedback was taken from the students and the students were actively participated in the session.

Conclusion:

The National Pharmacovigilance Week was successfully conducted with 5 sessions, covering various aspects of pharmacovigilance. The program aimed to raise awareness about the importance of pharmacovigilance and promote a culture of safety among healthcare professionals and patients. 70 students were registered for this Program and 52 students are eligible to get the certificate as they have more than 70% attendance. Participants engaged actively in the sessions, and feedback was overwhelmingly positive.
