The feedback from participants indicated a significant improvement in their skills and preparedness for corporate environments.



FIELD VISIT

The Government of Telangana has launched the "Parivarthana" initiative to raise awareness among school children, college students, and educational institutions in Hyderabad about drug abuse and trafficking. On June 25th, 2024, a rally and human chain event took place at Jalavihar, Hyderabad, with around 35 students from NNREGI participating. The event was inaugurated by Sri Sandeep Shandilya, DGP of the Narcotics Wing, and flagged off by Deputy Chief Minister Sri Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka, with special guests like Olympics shooter Esha Singh and singer Anjana Sowmya. Activities included motivational films and slogans such as "Say


