On 24.10.2024 an enlightening webinar titled "Global Opportunities for Pharmacists" was organized by Elite Expertise and held in the NNRG School of Pharmacy Seminar Hall. The session was led by speakers Sahana and Sena J., attracting an audience of 120 B. Pharmacy students from the third and fourth years. The speakers discussed career prospects for pharmacists in various countries, providing insights into the demand for pharmacy professionals worldwide. They highlighted opportunities in the USA, Canada, Australia, and the UK, detailing the qualifications and skills needed to work abroad. The session was highly informative, guiding students on pursuing international careers and adapting to global pharmacy standards.



An awareness study program was organised by Global Tree, Hyderabad, at the NNRG School of Pharmacy Seminar Hall on 23.10.2024 Mr. Md. Omkar Khalid, the Managing Director of
