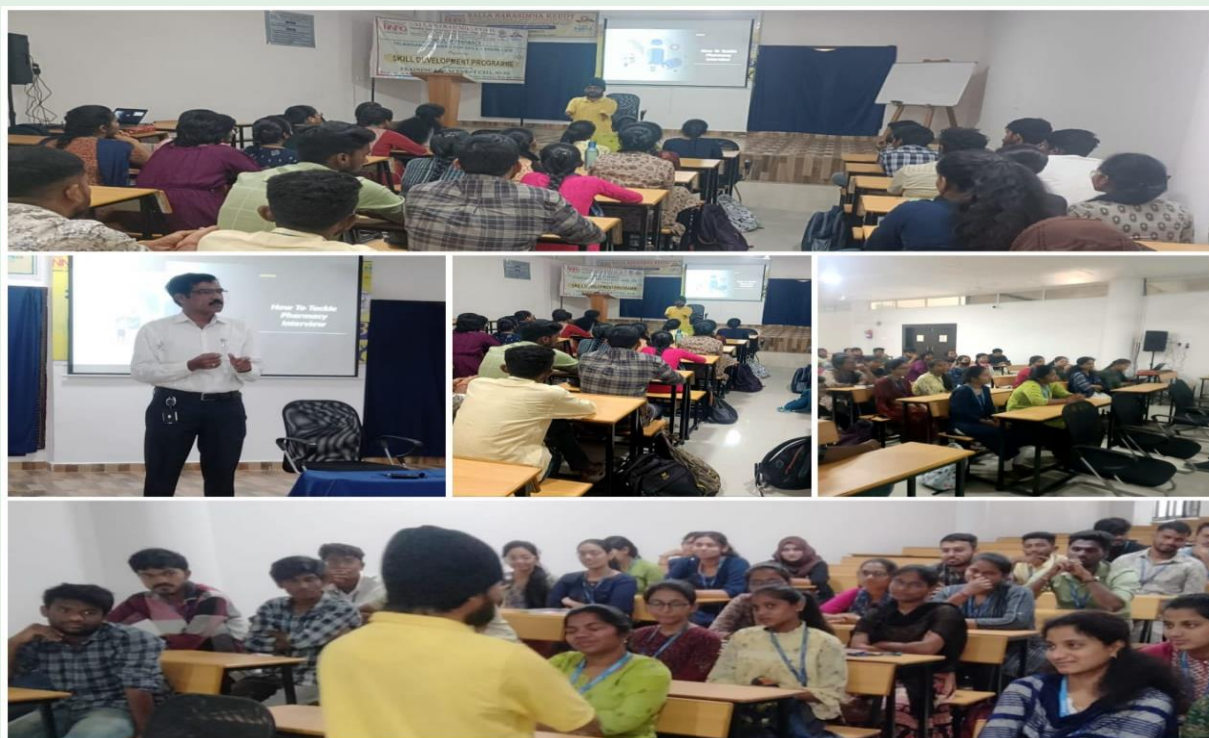


## **SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM**
