**BRIEF REPORT OF THE ORIENTATIN PROGRAM FOR FIRST YEAR B.TECH. STUDENTS AND PARENTS HELD ON 5<sup>th</sup> August 2019 AT 11 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM.**

The Nalla Narasimha Reddy Education Society's Group of Institutions has conducted Orientation Program for I B.Tech. students who have taken admission in our college. Around 300 parents and students have attended the program. Mr. Akella Raghavendra Garu, founder of Akella Raghavendra Foundation and motivational speaker was invited as the Chief Guest. Hon'ble Secretary Sri Nalla Narasimha Reddy Garu has graced the occasion with his presence. The program formally inaugurated by lightening of lamp by the dignitaries and Vandemataram. The Chief Guest, Secretary, Director, Dean School of Engineering, CRO and HoD of H&S Department have been invited on to the dais and have been greeted with bouquets.

At the outset the Director Dr. C.V.Krishna Reddy extended his warm welcome to all the dignitaries on the dais, Deans of Pharmacy and Management Sciences, all HoDs , Faculty, Parents and Students to the program. He congratulated all the parents for choosing NNRG Institution to join their wards in B.Tech course. Director informed that as per the AICTE /JNTUH instructions, Institution is conducting 2-week Induction Program. He said that eminent speakers are being invited to deliver motivational speeches on personality development, communication skills and behavioral aspects for the benefit of all the first year students and they have been advised to attend Induction Program without fail. He said that the training which students get in these Centers will certainly enhance their technical expertise to face the challenges globally in the present scenario of job opportunities, and also to establish their own profession.

Finally he gave the message to the I year students that they have to work very hard, be punctual and regular to the College which are very important factors since it is very difficult to understand engineering subjects if they absent even a single class teaching. He requested all the parents that it is their ultimate responsibility to see that their wards attend the college regularly and they must also visit the college frequently to know about the academic record of their wards. Before concluding his speech, he advised all the students to inculcate good qualities from the first year itself to maintain good discipline, good behavior and take the academics seriously and strive hard to get good percentage of marks in all the four years to attain their ambition and goal. He conveyed to all the students to focus on the above important aspects and adopt them wholeheartedly for an excellent and bright future.

Dr. G. Janardhana Raju, Dean, School of Engineering warmly welcomed all the dignitaries on the dais, Deans, HoDs, parents and students for the Orientation Program and extended his congratulations to all the parents and students for taking admission in NNRG in B.Tech. 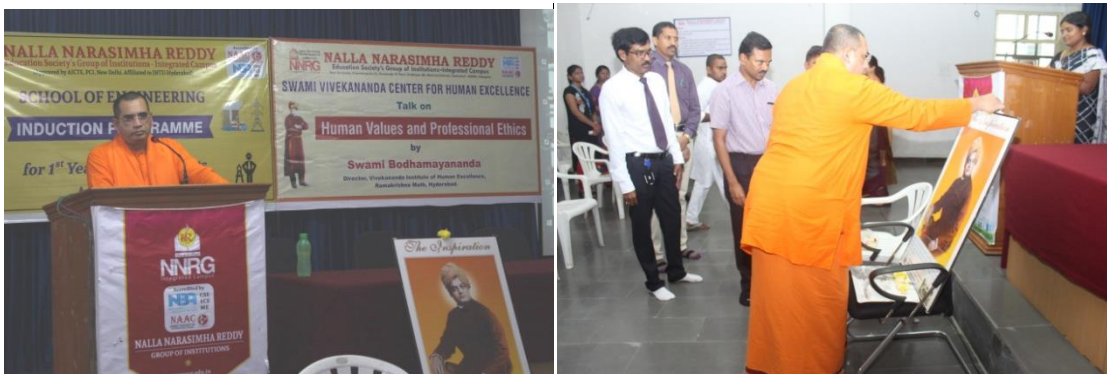
