

A Report on NNRG -National Level Model United Nations on 4th & 5th March 2025

The Department of Humanities and Sciences at NNRG launched its two-day National Level Model United Nations (MUN) on 4 March 2025, with an impressive array of participants and distinguished guests. The event, which has garnered registration from 106 students, began with an inspiring welcome address by Ms. Y.Rajya Laxmi, Assistant Professor of English and Convenor of NNRG MUN'2K25.
