On August 20, 2025, Dr. B. Ravi, Head of the ECE Department, addressed the first-year B.Tech ECE students and their parents about the significance of the ECE branch. He emphasized that the department has spacious laboratories and state-of-the-art equipment. Dr. Ravi highlighted that ECE students have the flexibility to work in either hardware or software domains. He also discussed the abundant opportunities in government sectors such as ISRO, defense laboratories, and other public organizations, in addition to the IT sector. Dr. Ravi mentioned that software is accessible to everyone, and emphasized the department's available facilities and the presence of 10 Ph.D. scholars. Furthermore, he noted that over 80% of the B.Tech (ECE) students have secured placements in hardware companies, and emphasized the increasing demand for ECE students in the near future.

The department specializes in areas such as Structural Engineering and Water Resource Engineering. Professor Srinivas also highlighted the potential for B.Tech (Civil) Engineering students to secure good placements in both the government and private sectors.

Dr. E. Additionally, he emphasized the importance of attending labs, keeping a record of Biometric Attendance, and updating

attendance in the ERP portal. He informed that a WhatsApp group would be created for sharing information, and requested parents to attend Parents Meeting and respond to messages sent to them.
