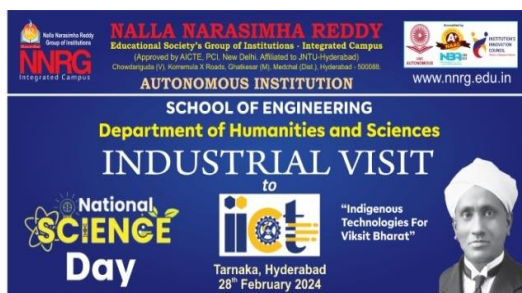
SCIENCE CLUB ACTIVITIES

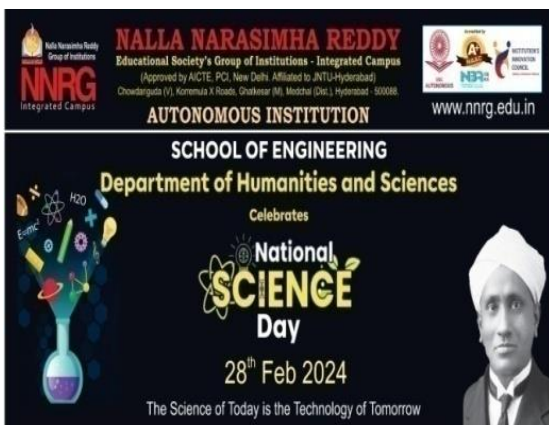
