## Devinette (Quiz)

As part of **Tech Samprathi**, held on **19th and 20th February 2025**, the **Department of Humanities and Sciences** organized the **Devinette (Quiz) Competition**. The primary objective of this event was to encourage students to enhance their problem-solving abilities and prepare them for the competitive challenges they may face in preliminary rounds of engineering and technology exams. The competition was conducted in two rounds: **Screening Round (Round-I)** and **Final Round (Round-II)**.

### Screening Round:

A total of **393 students** participated in the screening round, forming **131 teams**, each consisting of **3 members**. This round was held on **17th February 2025**, with a registration fee of Rs. 50 per team. Based on their performance in the screening test, **11 teams** were shortlisted for the final round.

**Final Round:** The **final round** consisted of five exciting stages:

1. Current Affairs
2. General Knowledge
3. Science & Technology
4. Visual Round
5. Rapid-Fire Round

For the final round, a registration fee of Rs. 350 per team was charged. The rounds were conducted by the **HOD** and the **Mathematics faculty**.

**Prizes:** After a competitive series of rounds, the winners were selected based on their scores, as recorded in the judge's report. The prize distribution for the final round was as follows:

- **1st Prize:** Rs. 2500 and a certificate
- **2nd Prize:** Rs. 2000 and a certificate
- **3rd Prize:** Rs. 1000 and a certificate
