- To encourage students to engage with India's cultural and national landmarks

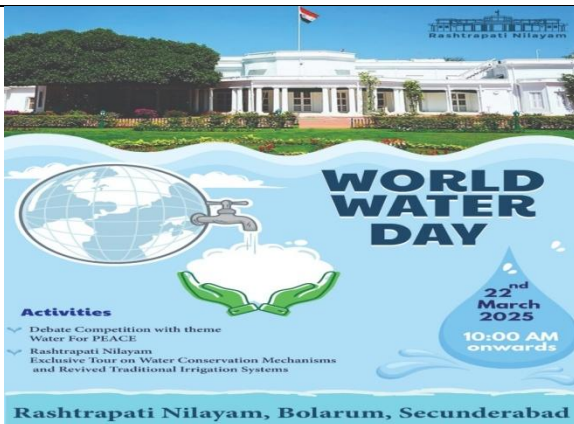

**President's Dining Area:** Visited the exclusive dining area used by the President. Gained insights into the formal dining protocols and arrangements for distinguished guests.

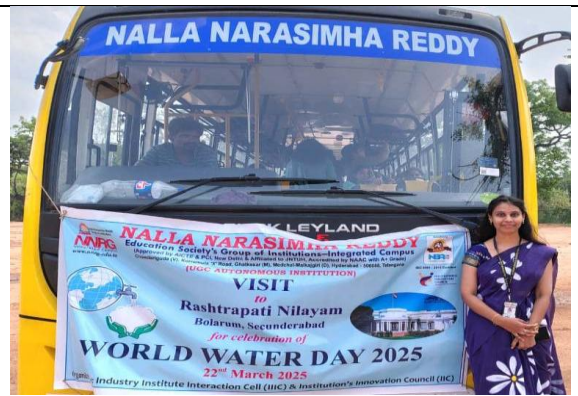
