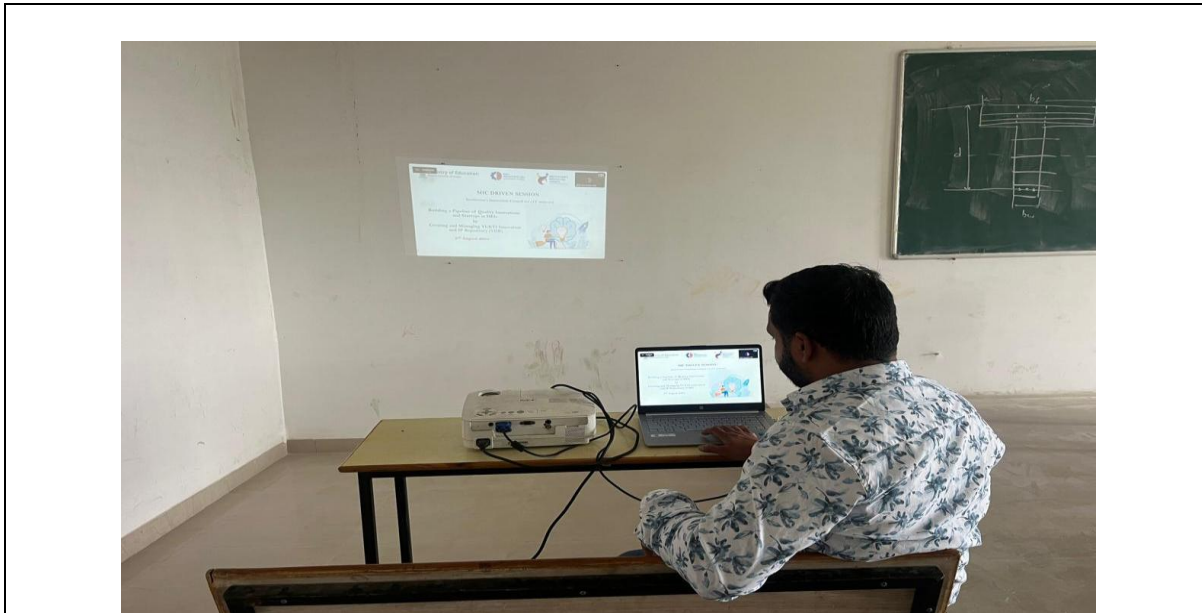

Speaker emphasized on System required for benchmarking practices of startups and graduated startups. Identifying potential individual entrepreneurs has become a challenging task for institutions which requires mentoring and guidance. The speaker also highlights the efforts put by HEI's through IIC in scouting innovations. Speaker discusses the importance of more high quality ideas and quality innovations. The video covers lack of objective in resource utilization, and resource allocation and mis-utilization of resources without clear approach . Speaker also talks on quest for a strong and continuous pipeline of innovations for startups.

While addressing the gathering, The speaker discussed the Institutional challenges. He also focused upon the key four stake holders of YIIR, namely 1. Innovators 2. Ecosystem 3. IIC Institutions 4. Mentors. And also shared Features of YUKTI like innovation Repository, networking tools, resource access and how it works
