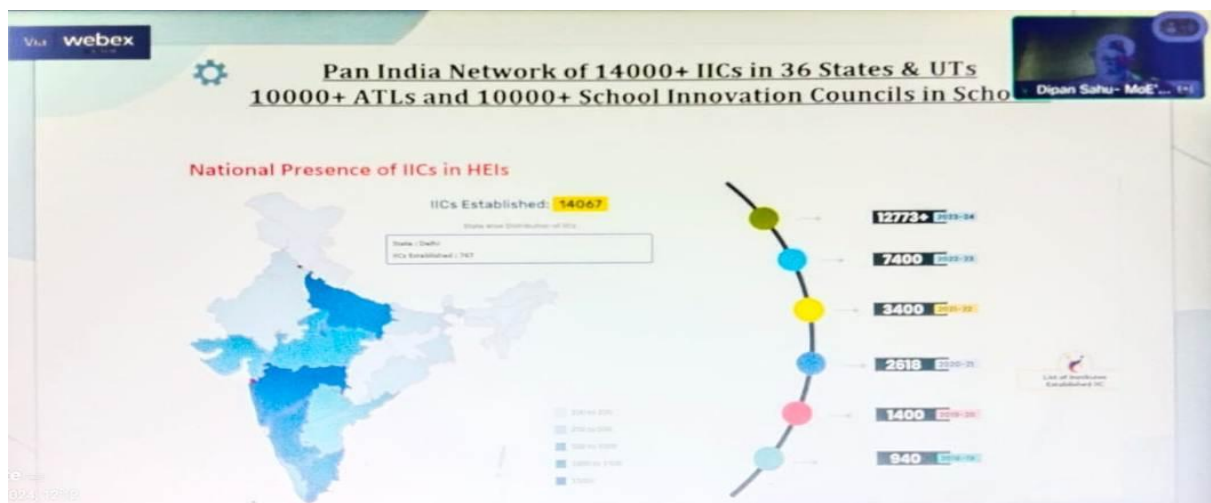


Mr Abhishek Ranjan briefing about the ATL – IIC Linkage program on 31-07-2024

Mr Dipan Sahu while addressing the orientation session said that the IIC Institutions must approach the nearby schools to establish the linkage with Atal Tinkering Labs (ATLs) and School Innovation Council (SIC). Also said that 14067 IICs established in 36 states and UTs.

While speaking Mr Dipan Sahu emphasized that AICTE, MoE Innovation Cell and Atal Innovation Mission have collaborated to provide mentoring support to ATLs. Some of the salient features of ATL – IIC Mentorship Linkage Program were also discussed in addition to proposed activities of ATL – IIC Mentorship Linkages. Figure shows the current status of ATL and IIC linkages.

Salient Features of ATL-IIC Mentorship Linkage Program

- One IIC with 3 ATLs- Both-way Search, Select, and Invite options available for IIC and ATLs
- Drop and Add option enabled for managing non-responsive IICs/ATLs while mapping
- Innovation Ambassadors to support Mentors and extend mentoring support to ATLs in conducting activities.
- Induction of ATL coordinator into 'My Council' of the IIC Institute as an external member.
- Login-based solution for ATLs and IICs for mentoring activities, performance/ progress monitoring & report generation.
- Inviting ATLs to participate in Innovation & Entrepreneurship activities organized by IIC Institutes.
- IICs to participate in Innovation & Entrepreneurship activities organized in ATLs.
- Extended support to ATLs in building YUKTI Innovation Repositories at the School level to get mentorship support.

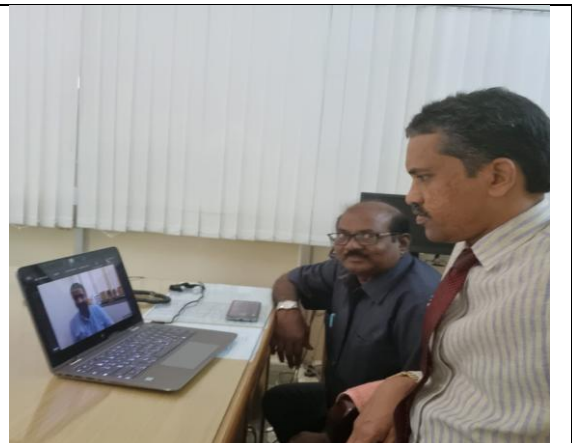
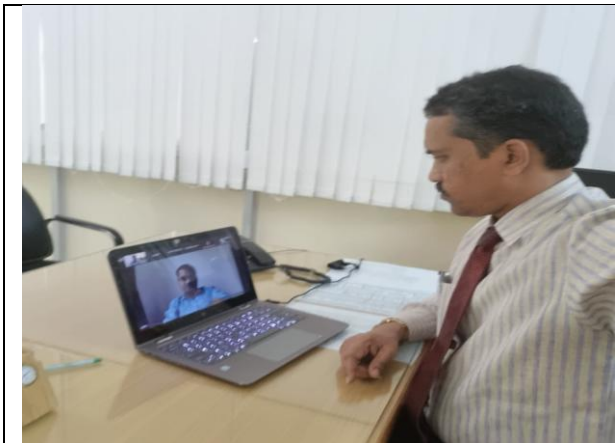
