

In Telugu, 'Bathukamma' means 'Mother Goddess come Alive' and Goddess Maha Gauri-'Life Giver' is worshipped in the form of Bathukamma - the patron goddess of womanhood, Maha Gauri Devi It is the festival for feminine felicitation. 





